

## **Larry Anderson**

Larry Anderson has been the partnering coordinator for the Woodrow Wilson Bridge replacement program since construction started in 2001. Larry's partnering program has earned national renown. Partnering has involved 18 separate construction or mitigation contracts, varying in size from \$3 million up to \$206 million. The partnering program has been remarkably successful in avoiding claims and promoting an atmosphere of shared interest.

Too often, construction partnering starts off with a bang—and then peters out. Larry's disciplined approach was the secret ingredient that kept Woodrow Wilson Bridge partnering on track. Larry organizes and facilitates workshops and schedules follow-up meetings. He surveys participant attitudes before each meeting, presents the results, and helps make the follow-up meetings effective. Often Larry writes meeting minutes, freeing project personnel from this chore. Larry's minutes are timely, readable, and because he "speaks construction," they are right on target.

Larry spent 26 years in the Navy's Civil Engineer Corps, retiring as a Captain. As a naval officer, he acquired hands-on construction management experience at locations as distant as the South Pole. He is married, has two adult children, and is an avid sailing dinghy racer.
